

# inteers GETTING STARTED AS A SCRUBS VOLUNTEER THRU CAVE

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#### PHASE ONE: INITIAL INTAKE

- Application due by December 5. Before beginning the application gather two (2) letters of reference you will need them to complete the application. Applications are submitted online by visiting Volunteer Service Opportunities and looking for SCRUBS. Applications cannot be saved and edited later, and partial applications will not be considered. For more information, please see Becoming a Volunteer.
- 2. Interview. Once the completed application is received (this includes your character reference letters), applicants will be invited to interview virtually on December 4 or December 6 2pm 3:30pm. Interviews are conducted in a group format. Acceptance letters will be emailed by end of day December 8.
- **3. Health & Safety.** Applicants accepted into the program will receive an email to proceed with the next steps to be completed no later than January 30:

**Health Screening.** Accepted applicants will arrange for the following:

- a. 1st TB Test This test is done <u>at your own expense</u> and at a facility of your choice and may or may not be covered by your health insurance carrier. The 1st TB test must include the date/time the test was administered and read, site of where it was administered, the lot #, expiration date, manufacturer and the result must be recorded in mm. <u>This is due no later than your orientation</u> date.
- b. **2<sup>nd</sup> TB Test** Upon completion of your first TB test notify Enloe Volunteer Services. You will then be given instructions to schedule your 2<sup>nd</sup> TB test at **Employee Health** during your health screening appointment. This test is done free of charge. *Please note: your 2<sup>nd</sup> TB test must be administered by Enloe Employee Health*.
- **c. Immunization Records** At your health screening appointment be prepared to provide proof of the following immunization records.
  - i. COVID-19 vaccination 2 shots Pfizer/Moderna or 1 shot J&J/Janssen AND booster, if eligible
  - ii. Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) 2 shots OR proof of positive titer unless born prior to 1957
  - iii. Varicella (Chickenpox) 2 shots OR proof of positive titer unless born prior to 1957
  - iv. Tdap 1 injection since 2010

If you do not have proof of immunization for MMR or Varicella, titers will need to be drawn. Titers are blood tests that measure immunity to a given disease(s). *Please note that if your tests show you are not immune, it will take at least a month to complete the immunization process and additional cost may be incurred. If you are not fully vaccinated and boosted for COVID-19 you must complete an Enloe Medical Center exemption form.* 

**Online Safety Modules-** You will receive log-in credentials to complete regulatory training lessons through an online learning management system called OAK. Modules should be completed **no later than January 16**.

### PHASE TWO: ORIENTATION, TRAINING & EDUCATION

All volunteers attend General Volunteer Orientation on January 16 from 2pm – 4:30pm and then proceed with training per their specific area of service (dates on page 2). *Please note:* Instructions on where to go to have your name badge photo taken will be provided by Volunteer Services.

### PHASE THREE: ENROLLING IN CAVE AND COURSE REQUIREMENTS

SCRUBS volunteers are required to enroll in a 1-unit course through CSU Chico's <u>Community Action Volunteers in Education</u> (CAVE). Volunteers must be a current Chico State student and be enrolled in a minimum of 6-units. Volunteers are responsible for their own transportation to and from Enloe. CAVE will enroll all approved volunteers in the 1-unit course once pre-requisite volunteer requirements are completed. Below are the course requirements which are due by Sunday, May 5.

- Sign volunteer agreement
- Attend mandatory CAVE orientations on January 22 (M/W) or 23 (T/Th) from 4-5:30pm
- Complete a minimum total of 30 hours of volunteering
- Track hours utilizing CAVE's approved timesheet
- Complete two volunteer check-ins the week of March 4 and week of April 8
- Submit two volunteer reflection papers due March 3 and May 5
- Attend a Community Engagement Workshop and submit associated reflection paper by May 5
- Comply will all rules and regulations of CAVE, Enloe, and the University
