 - A. Action Item: Approval of moving forward with branded concept (Panera). Copies of the 10/16/18 memo that Clyde emailed to the committee last week were distributed. Clyde said within the next three years, with the minimum wage increase, assuming no other changes to Sutter Dining, Dining will no longer have a positive bottom line. She said the Marketplace lost over \$500,000 in 2017-18, which amounted to a loss of \$372,561 in cash operations (Retail) as a whole. Clyde said they surveyed the campus last year and 77% of the respondents were in support of bringing an outside company to campus. Current budget projections as well as the proposed bottom line including Panera were reviewed. Motion to approve moving forward with branded concept (Panera), as presented (Herbert/Schmechel) 8-0-0 MSC. Clyde said this approval allows the AS to move forward and she will be notifying Panera and Panda and will start work on the contracting process. She said the goal is to be able to move forward with plans by December 17 in order to allow construction this summer. Clyde said if they don't meet that goal, would then have to do construction during the summer of 2020. It was noted that construction would take approximately two months and Buckley said they will have to push to get construction done so quickly. He said they would keep the committee updated.
