- VII. **BUSINESS**
 - A. **Action Item: Name change request from Conference Services to Event Services – Motion to Approve name change request from Conference Services to Event Services (Ly/Mirza) 5-0-0 MSC.**
 - B. **Information item: Student Union Capital Expenditure Reports for quarter ending 6/30/25-** Murzakulova recognized Katrina Leach, who delivered the report on Student Union Capital Expenditures through 6/30/25. For the year, the union expended \$492,949 in capital projects between the WREC and the BMU.
 - C. **Information item: Appointment of Vice Chair –** Murzakulova announced the appointment of Andrew Ly as Vice Chair of ASFC for the 2025-2026 term.
- VIII. **STAFF REPORTS**— Cox shared that the College of ECC has a capstone expo in December, where all the students' capstone projects are displayed. There is also a mixer where students can network with industry employers.
McAllister-Knutson encouraged everyone to get tickets for the NEZZA concert this weekend in the BMU. she reminded everyone that Wildcat Preview is this weekend, and she announced the next concert on Kendal Lawn is coming up on October 25th
