### **BALLOT ADVISORY MEASURE**

Should the Associated Students encourage the University to declare a Chico State Green New Decade with the following goals for the next ten years:

- Achieving 100% campus climate neutrality by investing in locally produced green energy and affordable, safe and accessible alternative transportation.
- Incorporating climate change education into all fields of study, while underscoring the intersectionality between climate change and wider issues of institutionalized racism, imperialism, militarism, colonialism, and class exploitation.
- Making higher education affordable for all students—especially students from frontline communities—by lowering campus fees and addressing issues of student housing and food insecurity.
- Encouraging students to strive for a just and fair society based on ecology and social equity, underscoring the injustice that those least responsible for the climate crisis suffer the most.
- Educating students on the diversity of global activism for climate justice and inviting them to realize their potential as advocates for a livable future while in school and after graduation.
- Providing more safe and inclusive school spaces for students of all backgrounds and better protecting them from discrimination and violence on campus and in the community.
