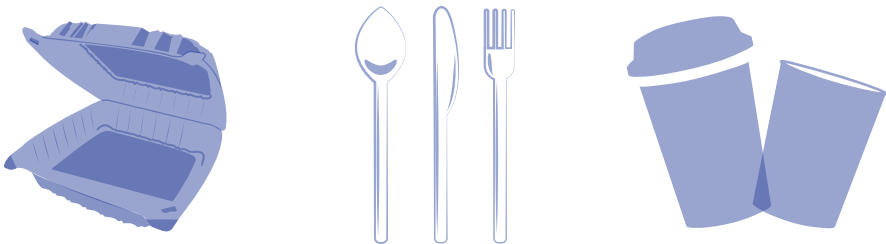


DO'S & DON'TS FOR Recycling

NON-Recyclable Items

- Plastic cups (**not even #1 PET**)
- Plastics #3, #6, or #7
- Plastics without any recycling code
- Glass from windows, picture frames, eye glasses, or non-food containers
- Pyrex glass
- Ceramics (**dishes or terracotta**)
- Carbon forms (**with the black carbon page**)
- Paper ream wrappers with plastic lining
- Paper plates or cups
- Coffee cups
- Tape or glue in large quantities (**small amounts are okay**)
- Styrofoam

WHAT IS RECYCLABLE AT CHICO STATE?

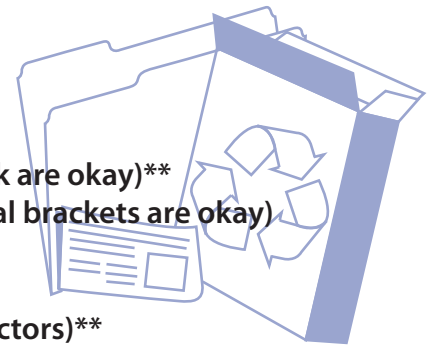
Cans & Bottles

- Aluminum cans
- Aluminum foil, pie plates, or trays (**must be clean**)
- Bi-metal cans (**tin/steel**)
- Plastic bottles (**usually #1 or #2**) - **no plastic cups!**
- Plastic "tubs" such as margarine, yogurt, or salsa (**usually #4 or #5**)
- Glass bottles or jars (**from food products only**)



Mixed Paper Types

- White and colored paper
- Staples and paper clips
- Newspapers
- Magazines and catalogs
- Phone books
- Books (**both paperback and hardback are okay**)**
- Envelopes (**plastic windows and metal brackets are okay**)
- Junk mail
- Carbonless forms
- Transparencies (**from overhead projectors**)**
- Cardboard or paperboard (**please flatten**)
- Miscellaneous office supplies (**file folders, binders, plastic sheet projectors, etc.**)**



Other Acceptable Items* » can be deposited in paper bins

- Toner and ink jet cartridges (**in packaging to prevent leaks**)**
- CD's, floppy disks, audio/video cassettes and plastic cases**
