

What is Recyclable at Chico State?

Cans & Bottles

- Aluminum cans
- Aluminum foil, pie plates, or trays (must be clean)
- Bi-metal cans (Tin/Steel)
- Plastic bottles (usually #1 or #2) – no plastic cups!
- Plastic “tubs” such as margarine, yogurt, or salsa (usually #4 or #5)
- Glass bottles or jars (from food products only)

Mixed Paper Types

- White and colored paper
- Staples & paper clips okay
- Newspapers
- Magazines & catalogs
- Phone books
- Books (both paperback & hardback are okay)**
- Envelopes (plastic windows and metal brackets okay)
- Junk mail
- Carbonless forms
- Transparencies (from overhead projectors)**
- Cardboard or paperboard (please flatten)
- Miscellaneous office supplies (file folders, binders, plastic sheet projects, etc.)**



Other Acceptable Items* → can be deposited in paper bins

- Toner & ink jet cartridges (in packaging to prevent leaks)**
- CD's, floppy discs, audio/video cassettes & plastic cases**

**For recycling of e-waste or hazardous waste, contact Environmental Health & Safety at 898-5126*

***Items that are not recyclable in a normal curbside bin*

NON-Recyclable Items

- Plastic cups (not even #1 PET)
- Plastics #3, #6, or #7
- Plastics without any recycling code
- Plastic bags or plastic films
- Glass from windows, picture frames, eye glasses, or other non-food containers
- Pyrex glass
- Ceramics (dishes or terracotta)
- Carbon forms (with the black carbon page)
- Paper Ream wrappers with plastic lining
- Paper plates or cups
- Coffee cups
- Tape or glue in large quantities (small amounts okay)
- Styrofoam
